### The inspiration

As the Western interiors world increasingly looks to the brilliance of Indian design, it is important to remember the titans who have shaped the country's current creative renaissance. To that end, this month we're shining a spotlight on the architect Charles Correa. He designed the Gandhi Memorial Museum in Ahmedabad among many monumental commissions, developing a style that rejected the influence of colonialism. Here, we look to the materials and colours of his own vibrant home, Verem Villas in Goa, which he shared with his wife Monika, a textile artist, until his death in 2015.

#### The interior

We may crave the heat of Indian summers, but you don't need the sun to be shining for this palette – all turmeric yellow, chilli red, green and pink - to work its magic in your home. In combination, these hues have the power to raise the temperature of a space all on their own! Be inspired by the artisan craftsmanship of the country with patterns that bring to mind intricate weaving techniques, or take a bold approach with colour-blocked walls and glossy finishes that speak to the beauty of lacquerware. How spicy you want to make things is entirely up to you.

Mustard yellow brings out the tones of the timber, while the addition of the bespoke vanity unit's built-in planter fills us with inspiration (anotherhuman.la). 2 Not often would we draw comparisons between the Kentish coastal town of Deal and India, but the combination of Farrow & Ball's 'Eating Room Red', 'Raw Tomatillo' and 'Cane' in the hallway of Russell Loughlan's Instagram-famous house has us feeling the heat (@thehouseondolphinst). 3 Stylist and co-owner of Manufacture Royale Lectoure Christèle Ageorges centred the palette of the hotel's lounge around the 'Oman' kilim by Elitis, picking out terracotta, khaki and ochre shades (lamanufacturerovaledelectoure.com).

The headboard in this bedroom is upholstered in a textile that brings to mind traditional Indian weaves, with the colours perfectly complementing Australian brand Sheridan's 'Abbotson' bedding in 'Raisin' (sheridan.com.au). 5 YSG Studio's interior for Superfreak café in Sydney offers a dialled-up take on this palette with avocado green, cork floors and pops of pink.
