

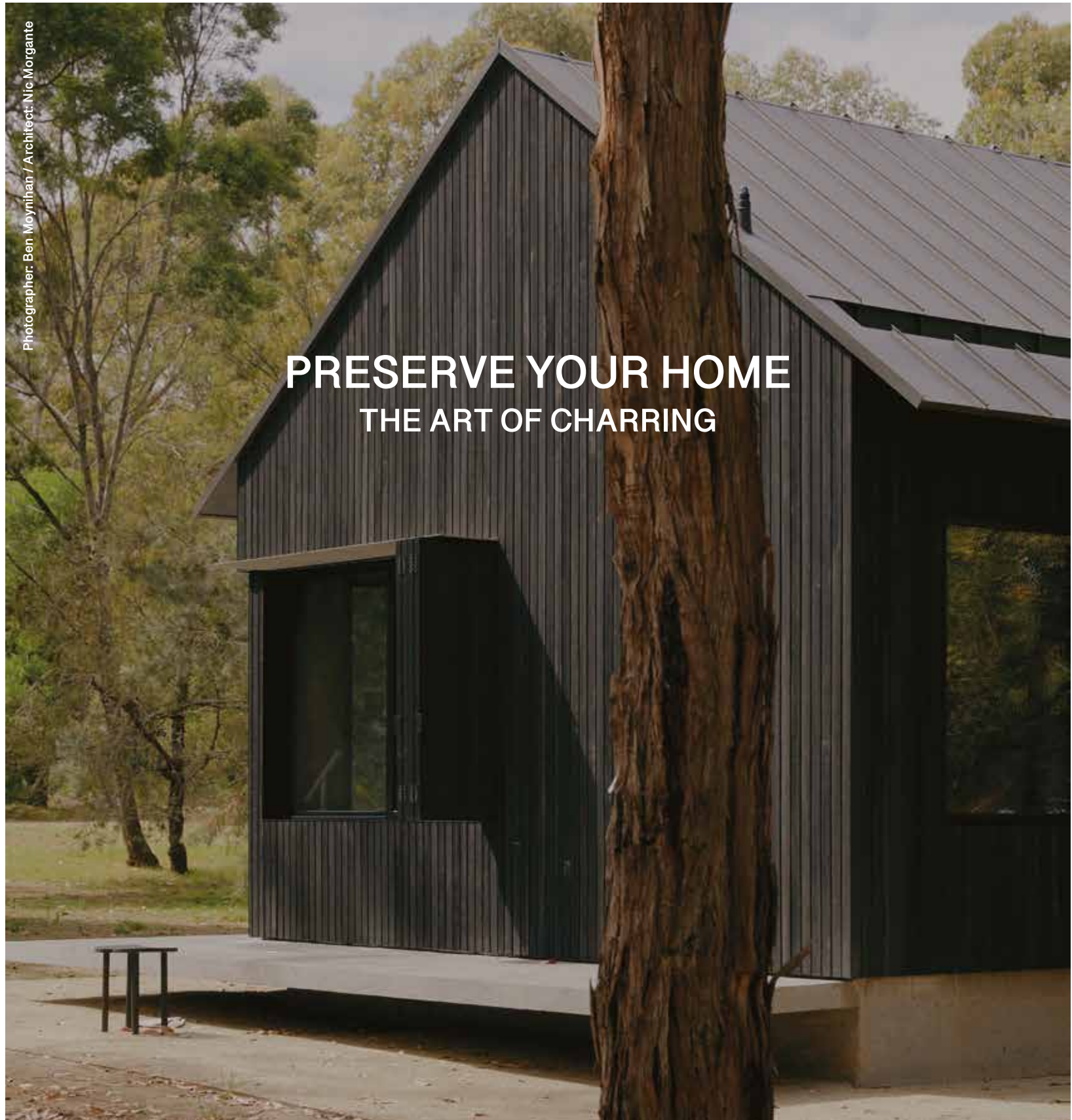


Open Dialogue

To create their new home, Adelaide practice studio gram began as they always do – by reading a space's potential, shaping a story, and letting that guide the design. Here, constraint became a catalyst: the raw bones of a former auto repair shop in Adelaide's inner north were kept intact – exposed concrete floors and steel softened with timber flooring and cladding. For founders Dave Bickmore and Graham Charbonneau, the story was rooted in community – a container for dialogue and companionship. Built by Build Inc, the 265-square-metre studio is open and adaptable, with mobile workstations and custom joinery that let it shift from daily practice to talks and exhibitions, layered with furniture and lighting from local makers, and contemporary works curated by Adelaide artist James Brown.
